## **Biarritz Conference** **2nd to the 5th October 2013**



This year's scientific conference is in Biarritz, one of Europe's most beautiful and stylish cities, resting on the French/ Spanish border. This coastal town embraces three cultures (French, Basque and Spanish). Moreover its mild climate makes it a good destination all year round. People are drawn to its stunning beaches, the surf, the golf, elegance and pure style.

From international festivals, Basque fiestas, art exhibitions, trade fairs, surfing competitions and golf tournaments, to shows, street theatre, forums... there is always something going on in Biarritz. Amongst the sites to visit is the Hotel Du Palais which was formerly the summer mansion of Napoleon III and Empress Eugenie; guests have included Queen Victoria, Frank Sinatra and Ernest Hemingway.

The conference and accommodation is at the four star Hotel Novotel Biarritz Anglet Aéroport. The hotel is also a good base to explore the Basque Country, for those staying on afterwards.

Over the past few years, AFMS/AFMB members have participated in several initiatives to raise the profile of the society, with the ultimate aim of attracting new membership. These have included the York teaching initiative, teaching workshops and lectures at French Universities, and the continuation of the successful Medical French weekend, now running annually in Warwick.
